JOB DESCRIPTION

The Clinical Research in Emergency Services and Treatments (CREST) Network is a multi-center, collaborative network at Kaiser Permanente that encourages, enables, and executes research in emergency medicine. More information can be found at: www.kpcrest.net. The CREST Network is looking to hire a Research Assistant. The ideal timeline for this position would be full time beginning June 2019, with part-time availability (to be discussed) beginning in May 2019, and with a preferred two-year commitment. Job tasks will include the following:

- Assist with research projects for the emergency medicine research network, including but not limited to: scheduling of study meetings, grant application submissions, database maintenance, conducting phone surveys, and reporting study data
- Collect emergency department core data measurements according to specific requirements and assist in preparing summary reports for the research team
- Assist in literature searches and retrieval of journal articles
- Assist with tables, figures, and references for study publications
- Assist in tracking study participants
- Enter data into Excel databases and generate reports
- Keep accurate records and files
- Attend weekly staff meetings; write and distribute detailed meeting minutes
- Order supplies and process expense reports
- May conduct structured telephone interviews with study participants
- May review questionnaires for completeness and accuracy, check for inconsistencies, and code open-ended questions
- May participate in the production of manuscripts and abstracts and present at national conferences
- Help maintain website
- Perform additional administrative tasks as necessary
- This position will be based at the Kaiser Permanente Division of Research in Oakland

- Bachelor's degree or equivalent experience in science, public health, or other related field required
- Previous experience in a research/health care environment preferred
- Training, experience or interest in emergency medicine research preferred

- Professional manner with a high degree of courtesy and sensitivity required
