Ill-Appearing Infant 61-90 Days

Ill-appearing infants are very high risk

- The AAP guideline and Roseville Protocol exclude ill-appearing infants because they are very high risk
- Data and analysis from KPNC febrile infants seen in the ED from 2010-2019 found that of those age 61-90 days who were ill-

appearing*: 4/54 (7%) had bacteremia without meningitis 2/54 (4%) had meningitis

*with or without high-risk factors

Recommendations for this infant

- Consult with Pediatrics
- Hospital admission
- A full septic work-up
 - CBC, UA, CSF studies, and blood, urine, and CSF cultures
- Parenteral antibiotics
