

Ill-Appearing Infant 29-60 Days

Ill-appearing infants are very high risk

- The **AAP guideline and Roseville Protocol** exclude ill-appearing infants because they are very high risk
- **Data and analysis** from KPNC febrile infants seen in the ED from 2010-2019 found that of those age 29-60 days who were ill-appearing*: *11/138 (8%) had bacteremia without meningitis*
3/138 (2%) had meningitis

**with or without high-risk factors*

Recommendations for this infant

- Hospital admission
- A full septic work-up
 - CBC, UA, CSF studies, and blood, urine, and CSF cultures
- Parenteral antibiotics
